



K-UTEC in Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan

From 24-29 April 2023, Dittmar Lack and Dr Sebastian Lüning took part in the Thuringian Business Days in Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan. The delegation trip was organised by the State Development Corporation (LEG) of Thuringia and was competently led by the Minister of Economics, Wolfgang Tiefensee, and his State Secretary, Carsten Feller. With 44 participants, it was one of the largest German delegations to the region in recent times.

During the trip, K UTEC held productive mining-specific talks with ministers, chambers of commerce, and company representatives from the resource-rich region in Astana and Tashkent. Six months earlier, the German Foreign Minister Annalena Baerbock had already visited the two countries and expressed her wish for the expansion of economic relations. K-UTEC is in a position to actively support companies in Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan, particularly in the areas of potash, lithium, mining safety, mining backfill, and mineral exploration.
